## Time Machine: August 1996

CRRC hosted a 2 day Open class sailplane contest on August 3-4, 1996. This was the first contest conducted at the Davis Farm Field in Sudbury, Mass. and all went very smoothly. We were initially worried that the field might be a bit too small, but it was able to comfortably accommodate 3 winch lines, 2 landing circles, and about 25 contestants.

Day 1 was CD'd by Fritz Bien, who imposed a challenging set of tasks. The first round was 6 minute duration, and each ensuing round was one minute longer than the last. The last round, at 12 minutes, was a real killer if you didn't make your time!

John Nilsson was the Contest Director on Day 2. Being a much more reasonable sort, John called for 7 minute rounds, with one 5 minute task flown within the first 3 rounds, at the discretion of the pilot.

At our October meeting, Dean won a BNF Beaver float plane, Dave M. won a low voltage alarm, and Adam took home a flap deflection angle tool.

For show & tell, Adam showed us a new large-capacity LiFe battery with many convenient features that could be used for field charging. Joe L. talked about his Hobby Eagle A3Pro v2 6-Axis gyro that he's had a lot of fun with. Mike showed us two different models of FAA-compliant RemoteID broadcast modules, and Tony D. showed and demonstrated a Star Wars-style light saber with lights and motion-triggered sound effects. 
# **School Street Flying Schedule**

# **FAA** Registration

Please remember to visit <a href="https://faadronezone.faa.gov/#/">https://faadronezone.faa.gov/#/</a> to check and renew your FAA registration ID. Also, beware some commercial entities who are claiming to process registrations - often for increased prices. The FAA charges \$5 for a three-year registration, or extension.

Check your registration when you mark each new plane/drone, so you don't miss a renewal!

## **TRUST Test**

The FAA has authorized several organizations including the AMA to administer the knowledge and safety test required by congressional action.

You are now required to show proof of passing the test (along with your FAA ID number) to law enforcement or FAA representatives upon request.
